

Czech Economy Briefs

The Czech Finance Ministry revised its economic growth outlook for this year up to 2.7% from 1.7% in April. For 2015, the ministry expects the economy to expand by 2.5% compared to a 2% growth in the April forecast. The economic growth for 2016 and 2017 is also projected at 2.5%. Average inflation could be only 0.6% this year, but in 2015 it should accelerate to 1.7% according to the ministry's forecast. The public finance deficit should reach 1.5% of GDP in 2014, the same as last year.

The Czech Republic's **state budget surplus** grew to Kc4.5bn in July from June's Kc1.5bn, while last year in July, state budget ended in a Kc27.6bn deficit, the Finance Ministry announced in August.

The Czech Republic **trade surplus** reached Kc19.1bn in June, which was by about 4.1bn more than last year. The year on year exports grew by 12.9% and imports by 11.9%. The domestic automakers, which increased their market shares in a number of key markets after launching new car models, continued to make good. Also exports of machinery, computers and electric devices increased. The pace of the growth of imports is driven up mainly by a renewed domestic demand, both by enterprises and households.

Unemployment in the Czech Republic remained at 7.4% in July. Unemployment has been falling since January when it reached 8.6%.

Average interest rate on mortgage loans in the Czech Republic dropped to 2.72 % in July, a new record low again since 2003 when the indicator started to be monitored, according to the Fincentrum Hypoindex data calculated by consulting company Fincentrum.

The **Czech National Bank** (CNB) Board kept interest rates unchanged at technical zero (0.05%) again on its last August meeting.

Czech exporters expect to lose contracts worth tens up to millions of Czech crowns at the most over the current sanctions between the EU and Russia in the next 12 months, according to a poll conducted by the Czech Economic Chamber among nearly 140 Czech firms. There are signals of a deteriorating payment discipline on the part of their Russian partners, which leads decrease in bilateral confidence. Entrepreneurs that will be affected by the sanctions are trying to adjust their production and business programmes and to find customers on alternative markets.

Business Briefs



Czech company **MSA**, manufacturer of industrial valves, won a tender to supply an Australian company Valve Distributors Pty Ltd. The order includes ball valves in nominal size 4", Class 600 in special design: valves will be equipped with underground set, gearbox will be under ground and valve will be operated by extension and square wrench. "This particular design is special and is not commonly used, but we have experience with this specific design from different projects realized in the past" describes order overseas territory sales director Stanislav Herudek.

First Czech Business Networking in Sydney organized by the Consulate of the Czech Republic and the CzechTrade office took place on the 7th August 2014. There were some 20 participants interested in the potential Czech exports to Australia and getting in touch with the government bodies and other business people.

The Czech government signed in July investment agreements with two South Korean companies – **NEXEN** (tyre maker) and **Hyundai Mobis**. The latter firm will invest up to Kc4bn to build a plant for car headlamps near Ostrava, northern Moravia. The NEXEN investment agreement is worth Kc22.8bn. In the first years Nexen will create at least 1,000 jobs in industrial zone Triangle in the Ustecky region, north Bohemia, where it will operate. In the future, Nexen may invest up to Kc4obn in the Triangle zone, which would be the highest investment a foreign company has ever made in the Czech Republic.

Prague is the 22nd most frequently visited city in the world and ninth most popular destination city in Europe, according to the Global Destination Cities Index for 2014, released by the MasterCard association. The Czech capital has overtaken Berlin, Madrid and Warsaw, for example, in popularity.

A Prague-based firm **Projektmedia** has developed a computerised, interactive device half teaching tool,



half toy, called a **Magic Box**. The device is a small box on wheels, equipped with a powerful data processor and projector, which screens interactive games, software and web-based programmes onto a large surface laid on the floor, enabling children to play and work together while learning how to use a computer. The Magic Box is proving very popular with children of different age and learning abilities. During first three months the company sold more than a hundred pieces. The Magic Box was the recipient of the Grand Prix award at the Trade Fair for Toys in Prague in 2013. The company has been working on several language mutations including Arabic, as Koweit and Saudi Arabia wish to buy 2000 devices.


Czech exports to Australia and New Zealand

According to the latest export data of the Czech Statistical Office, exports from the Czech Republic to Australia reached 292 mil.USD and exports to New Zealand 39 mil.USD from January to June 2014. In total it is 17% down compared to the same period in 2013. The fall is mostly due to lower exports of passenger vehicles to Australia. Total Czech exports to Australia have decreased by 21% y/y, on the other hand to New Zealand have increased by 31%.



Passenger vehicles and toys continue to be the leading export articles to Australia and New Zealand in 2014, with growing dominance of Škoda cars.


Following graph displays the dynamics of major commodity exports in 2013 and first half of 2014 in Australia:



In Australia, exports from the Czech Republic in the first six months of 2014 have decreased by significant 21% compared with the same period of 2013. Orders for passenger vehicles decreased by 7,5% and toys orders decreased by 4,5%. Czech Crown remains weak against Australian Dollar (mainly due to the interventions of the Czech Central Bank) which may contribute to the recovery of Czech exports in the

second half of 2014. Passenger vehicles market in Australia may however also be affected by recently signed FTAs between Australia and Japan and South Korea, reducing the price of Asian vehicles in Australia.

Following graph displays the dynamics of major commodity exports in 2012 and 2013 in New Zealand:



In New Zealand, a number of commodity categories increase in export volume in the first half of 2014 compared to the same period of 2013, indicating new export opportunities for industrial machinery, electric plants and generators, newly also for prefabricated buildings. Main export articles, LEGO toys orders remain slightly subdued, Škoda passenger vehicle orders increased by 78% in the period. Overal Czech export to New Zealand has increased by 31% in the period.
