Conditions of the admission procedure (deadline for submission of applications, deadlines for entrance examination, required knowledge, administration fee etc.) are announced by the dean of relevant faculty.

POSSIBILITIES OF STUDY AT UWB

A) STUDIES WITH THE INTERSTUD PROJECT SCHOLARSHIP SUPPORT

Study in study programmes taught in the Czech language with the Interstud project support is for free. The applicant covers an administration fee of 500 CZK for admission procedure. The project Interstud supports excellent students of technical and natural science programs especially from the non EU countries (e.g. Belarus, Ukraine, Uzbekistan, Armenia etc.). The project is designed only for applicants with finished secondary school education!

Students involved in the Interstud project will complete an intensive three months Czech language course and get a scholarship support for the first year of their study. The amount of scholarship support is 4,000 CZK per month and can increase/decrease depending on study results. The list of faculties participating in the project in 2015/2016:

Faculty of Applied Sciences, Faculty of Education, Faculty of Electrical Engineering, Faculty of Mechanical Engineering, Ladislav Sutnar Faculty of Design and Art (specific regulations for applicants)

Every applicant for study with Interstud scholarship support has to fill in the preliminary application form for Interstud (PAF): <http://www.kma.zcu.cz/fs/PAF> which is accessible only from September 1st to November 30th. After the preliminary registration the applicant receives information about following admission procedures. If the number of applicants from one foreign country is significant, the university organises an admission interview (December).

The applicant interested in studying with the Interstud scholarship support has to fill in a complete application form (CAF) until the middle of December: <http://www.kma.zcu.cz/fs/CAF>. The printed CAF must be sent by post together with all required annexes to the address of relevant faculty. Data from the interview and CAF together with enclosed documents are then considered by the Interstud project commission. The commission suggests a scholarship support and passes all the documents to the relevant faculty. The faculty decides about acceptance/non-acceptance of every applicant. The applicant receives the decision of the faculty in February/March 2015. The applicants also receive information on visa procedures.

In case the the Interstud scholarship support is not awarded the applicant can then fill in the electronic application form for study in the Czech or English study program without the scholarship support. In such case, the applicant covers all the costs connected with the study himself/herself (more information available in section B) Study in the Czech language or C) Study in the English language).

B) STANDARD STUDIES IN THE CZECH LANGUAGE

Study in study programmes taught in the Czech language is for free. The applicant has to fill in a standard electronic application form <http://eprihlaska.zcu.cz> until the end of March (respectively until the deadline announced by the relevant faculty). The applicant is asked to pay administration fee of 500 CZK for admission procedure. Afterwards the applicant receives an invitation for the admission procedure from the relevant faculty (usually before the end of May). The applicant can be accepted for study without the admission interview in exceptional cases. The overall information about admission procedure is provided by the relevant faculty.

C) STUDIES IN THE ENGLISH LANGUAGE

Study in study programmes taught in the English language is paid (4,000 EUR per academic year). The applicant has to fill in a standard electronic application form <http://eprihlaska.zcu.cz> until the end of March (respectively until the deadline announced by the relevant faculty). The applicant is asked to pay administration fee of 500 CZK for admission procedure. More details is provided by the relevant faculties and here: <http://international.zcu.cz>.
