## **One Flew Over the Cuckoo's Nest**

Forman's 1975 multi-Oscar Winner starring Jack Nicholson, Luise Fletcher, and Michael Berryman, follows a brash rebel, who upon arriving at a mental institution, rallies the patients to take on their oppressive dictator of a nurse, Mrs. Ratched. The film won 5 Oscars and another 30 awards, and is ranked #12 on IMDB's Top 250 Films of all Time list. (1975, 133 min, in english)



## **Valmont**

Set in Baroque France, VALMONT explores a scheming widow (Annette Bening) and her lover, Valmont (Colin Firth), who make a bet regarding the corruption of a recently married woman. Valmont bets that he can seduce the honorable woman. However, in the process of seducing her, he falls in love. Valmont is based loosely on the French novel Les Liaisons Dangereuses by Choderlos de Laclos. Forman first read the book while in Milan Kundera's screenwriting class in film school and it left a lasting impression on him. (1989, 137 min, in English)

Forman's Oscar-winning AMADEUS depicts the life of master musician Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart, told in flashback by his peer and secret rival Antonio Salieri, who now resides in a mental institution. F.
