Charles University in Prague (CU):

- founded in 1348 by the Holy Roman Emperor Charles IV
- belongs among the oldest, largest and most prestigious universities in the world
- ranked among the top 2% of the world's universities in Shanghai University's Academic Ranking of World Universities
- the number one university in Eastern Europe according to the Webometrics Ranking of World Universities

Faculty of Social Sciences (FSS CU):

- the second newest faculty of Charles University in Prague
- founded in 1990, shortly after the Velvet Revolution
- some of the highest quality English language Bachelors, Masters and PhD degree programmes in Central and Eastern Europe in all fields of social sciences
- 4 000 full-time students; approximately 150 of them are enrolled in one of our English language degree programmes
- one of the highest international mobility participation rates of all the faculties of Charles University; yearly we welcome approximately 500 exchange students from all over the world

Tuition Fees and Deadlines:

• The tuition fee for most programmes ranges from €6,000 to €7,000 per year. The fee for the BECES programme is €7,800 per year. The fee for EU students (including EEA-EFTA) for the IMESS programme is €9,000 per year. The fee for students from outside of the EU (including EEA-EFTA) is €15,500 per year.

• The application deadline for the 2013/14 academic year is 15 April 2013.
