

HOW TO APPLY

The final deadline for all English language degree programmes is April 15 of each year.

In general, all applications must include:

- Completed application form
- Copies of all relevant diplomas and transcripts
- Short academic resume detailing all relevant qualifications and experience
- Students who are not native speakers should include details of any tests of the English language they have taken

General eligibility requirements:

Prospective undergraduate students need a completed secondary education. Those applying to graduate programmes must hold a bachelor diploma in a related field of study.


