

Contracts concluded between Czech suppliers and MNCs, mediated by CzechInvest in 2001-2008, USD million; cumulative




Leave the legwork to us

Joint - Ventures

The establishment of a joint venture brings a range of advantages. Firms gain access to new markets much more rapidly than in the case of setting up a new branch or factory, but with substantially lower costs. At the same time, the partners in such a venture can utilise mutual distribution channels and marketing activities while sharing potential risks and high research and development costs.

Case Studies

Agrostroj to produce Japanese professional-grade lawnmowers, thanks to CzechInvest

Pelhřimov-based Agrostroj began in early 2009 production of large professional-grade ride on lawnmowers under the Japanese brand Chikusui Canycom. Annual production should total 1,000 machines.


Agrostroj Pelhřimov is the largest producer of agricultural technology in the Czech Republic, employing 1,200 people.

Agrostroj focuses on production of finished machines and tools; an ever greater part of its production involves cooperation with significant multinational companies.

"Exporting from Japan through half of the planet is relatively expensive and time-consuming, so we wanted to find a way to get closer to our European customers. After consultations with CzechInvest, it was clear that the Czech Republic was the ideal choice" says Hitoshi Kaneyuki, president of Chikusui Canycom.

From its expansive database CzechInvest then prepared for Chikusui Canycom a list of fifteen potential suppliers that could precisely meet the company's requirements. "We had visited five of the selected companies and in the end we chose Agrostroj Pelhřimov due to the quality of its production and testimonials from its existing clients," adds Hitoshi Kaneyuki.

"We expect that the close cooperation with our Japanese partner will bring more Japanese know-how into our company, resulting in higher quality and rationalisation of production. In future this will become apparent particularly in the area of innovations and improvements of the subject of our cooperation," says Lubomír Stoklášek, CEO of Agrostroj Pelhřimov.

Involvement of Czech suppliers in multinational supply chains

Wendell – Diooss&Celco – Matsushita (Panasonic)

In 2006 CzechInvest mediated contact between the Czech company DIOSS Nýřany and CELCO of Japan. DIOSS offered CELCO its manufacturing spaces which, upon completion of the existing production of batteries for Sanyo, provided the opportunity to use two halls suitable for technologically demanding production. The result is a joint venture of these two companies which supplies printed circuits to Panasonic AVC Networks Czech (Matsushita) in Plzen, which assembles LCD and PDP televisions.

Wendell Electronics, a Czech company involved in the third round of the Supplier Development Programme, was chosen as the supplier of circuit boards. This medium-sized Czech firm (240 employees) produces tailor-made electronics and components for use in consumer electronics, security systems, telecommunications, mechanical engineering and the automotive industry.

With CzechInvest's help, the Czech companies Diooss Nýřany and Wendell Electronics have secured orders worth CZK 350 million.

Development of Czech suppliers

Intensive contribution to company development and competitiveness based on the EFQM

CzechInvest has been running the Supplier Development Project since 2000. Since then the project has assisted more than 150 Czech small and medium-sized enterprises.

The goal of the Supplier Development Project is to improve the ability of Czech suppliers to compete, to secure good local sources for current investors operating on the domestic market and to increase the attractiveness of the Czech Republic for new investors. The process includes an initial overview of business activities and determination of priorities for further improvement. Within the process the selected suppliers will determine their priorities for further improvement and will formulate detailed long-term plans for improvement, which will enable them to meet the requirements of multinational companies.

Evaluation of suppliers business enterprise based on the model of the European Foundation for Quality Management and other methods with the goal of determining areas for improvement and suggesting specific steps leading to further development of supply abilities.
