The eligible applicants include the Czech private sector, NGOs, universities, state institutions and research centres.

The Czech-UNDP Trust Fund, predecessor of the Czech-UNDP Partnership, was established in 2004 as the first trust fund for Central Europe. Within 14 years, it supported successful implementation of 215 projects and initiatives.

16 countries from the region benefited from the Czech-UNDP Trust Fund by professional development of experts, creation of expert network and support for knowledge exchange, meeting international commitments and conditions for EU accession, creation of platforms for business to business, development of local private sector.

The total funding amounted to US\$ 10,200,338.
