

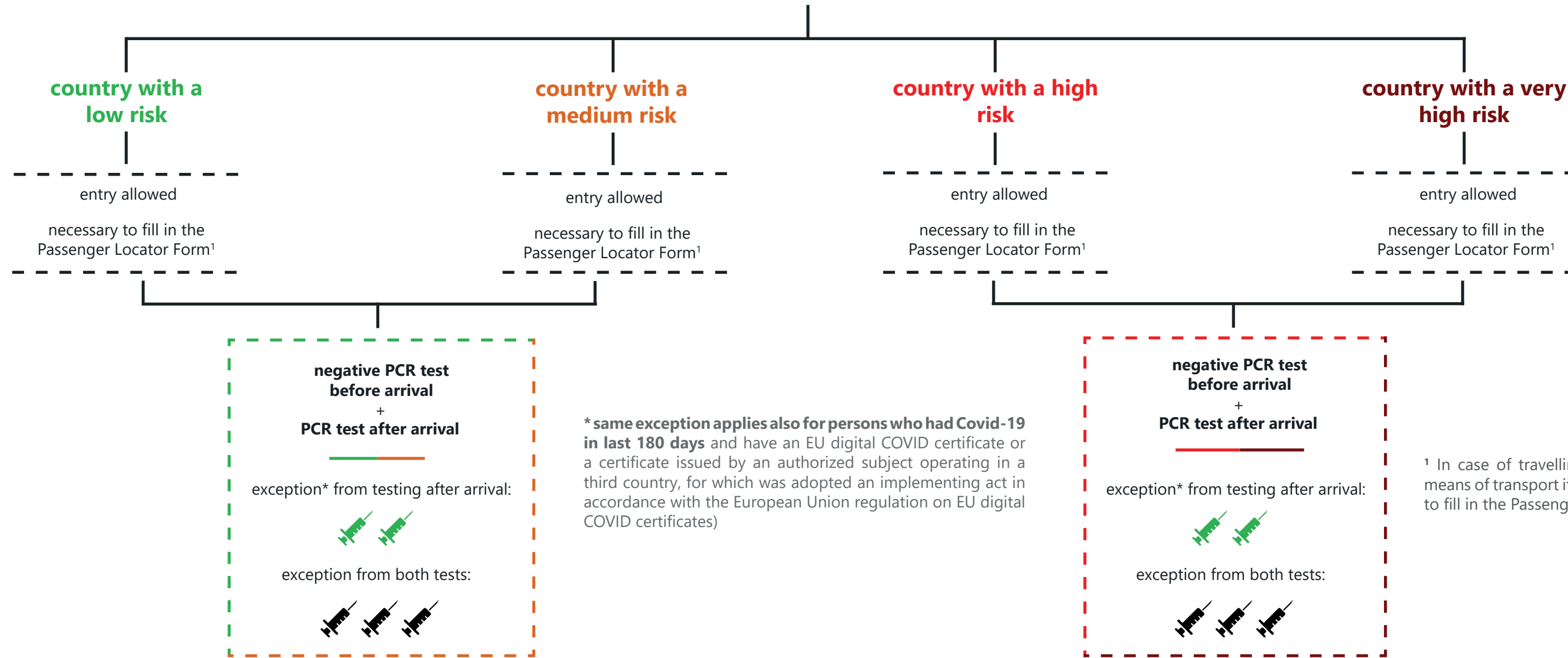
# Rules for entry and return to the Czech Republic (as of 27<sup>th</sup> December 2021)


## PART A.2

foreign nationals with a short-term visa issued after 11 May 2020 or long-term visa issued by the Czech Republic  
citizens of EU+ and foreign nationals with a long-term visa or a long-term or permanent residence permit issued by EU+

it is possible to enter the country for any reason

 **vaccinated persons** - 14 days after the application of the last dose - according to these rules:

- **vaccinated in the EU+** - it is necessary to have an EU digital COVID certificate
- **vaccinated outside of the EU+** - it is necessary to have an EU digital COVID certificate or a written confirmation which is published on the Ministry of Health website; **only vaccinations approved by EMA or products produced in compliance with the patent of the approved vaccinations are accepted**

 **persons meeting conditions of vaccinated persons who received also a COVID booster shot**

### Rules for testing:

#### Testing before starting the travel to the Czech Republic:

- 1) PCR no older than 72 hours
- 2) antigen no older than 48 hours

**Testing after arrival to the Czech Republic** - between 5<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> day after the arrival; until receiving a negative result of a test it is obligatory to wear a respirator outside of the accommodation.

Travellers from all countries have an obligation to fill in the Passenger Locator Form before the arrival.



There are several exceptions from the obligation to fill in the Passenger Locator Form or undergo testing. **All rules and exceptions can be found in the Ministry of Health Protective Measure.**



A list of countries with a low, medium and high risk of Covid-19 transmission can be found here. **A country listed in neither list of countries is considered as a country with a very high risk of Covid-19 transmission.**
