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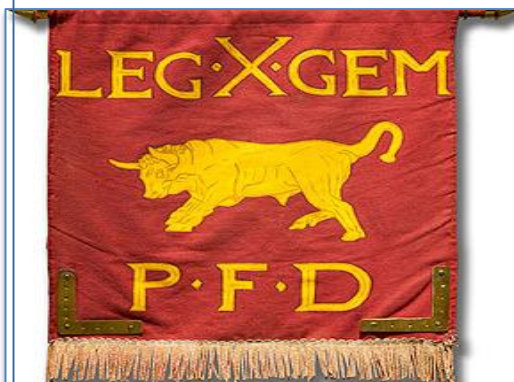

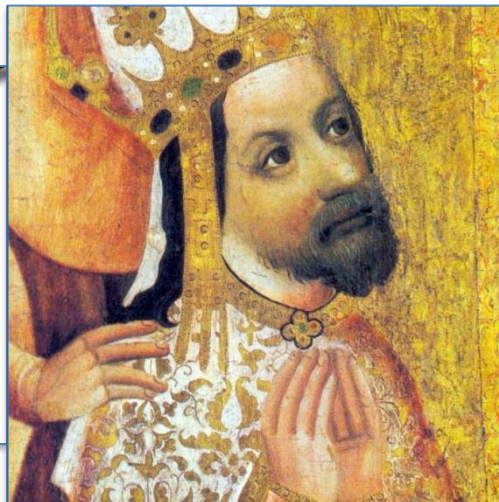


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Vine and Wine Path in the Czech Republic

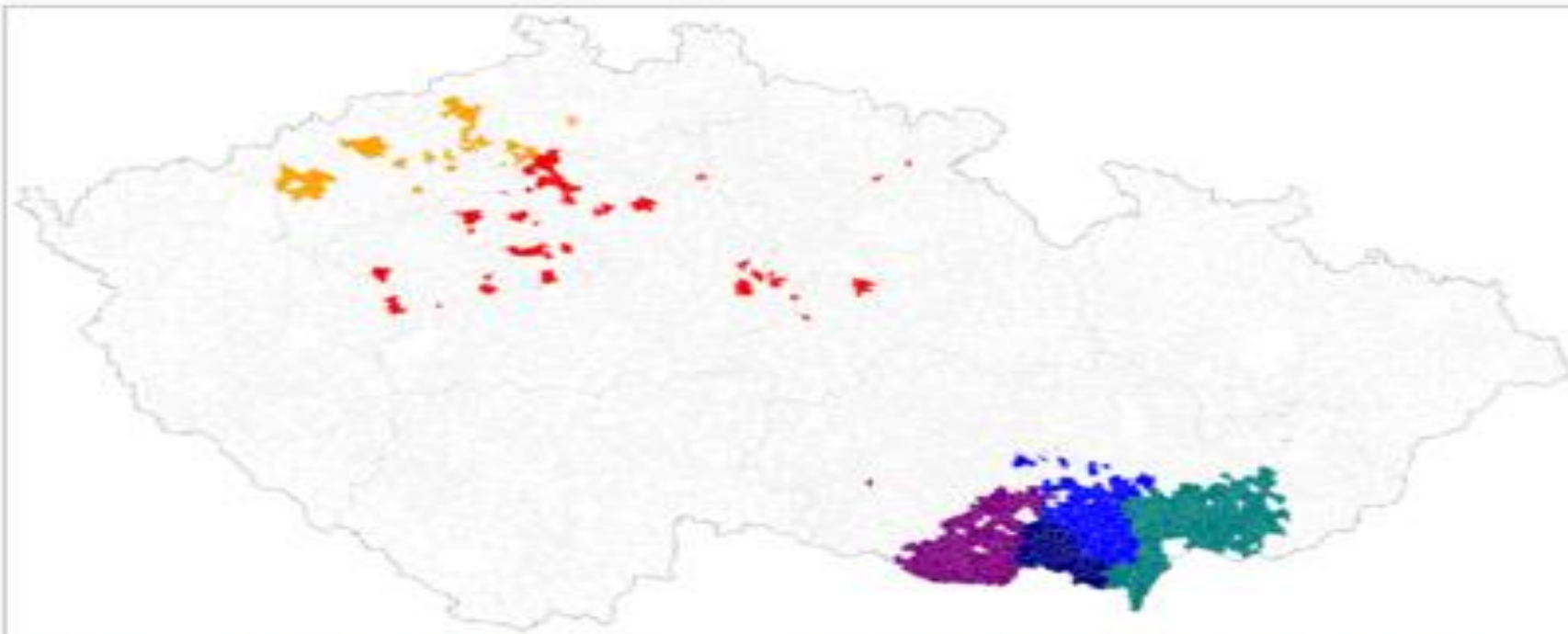

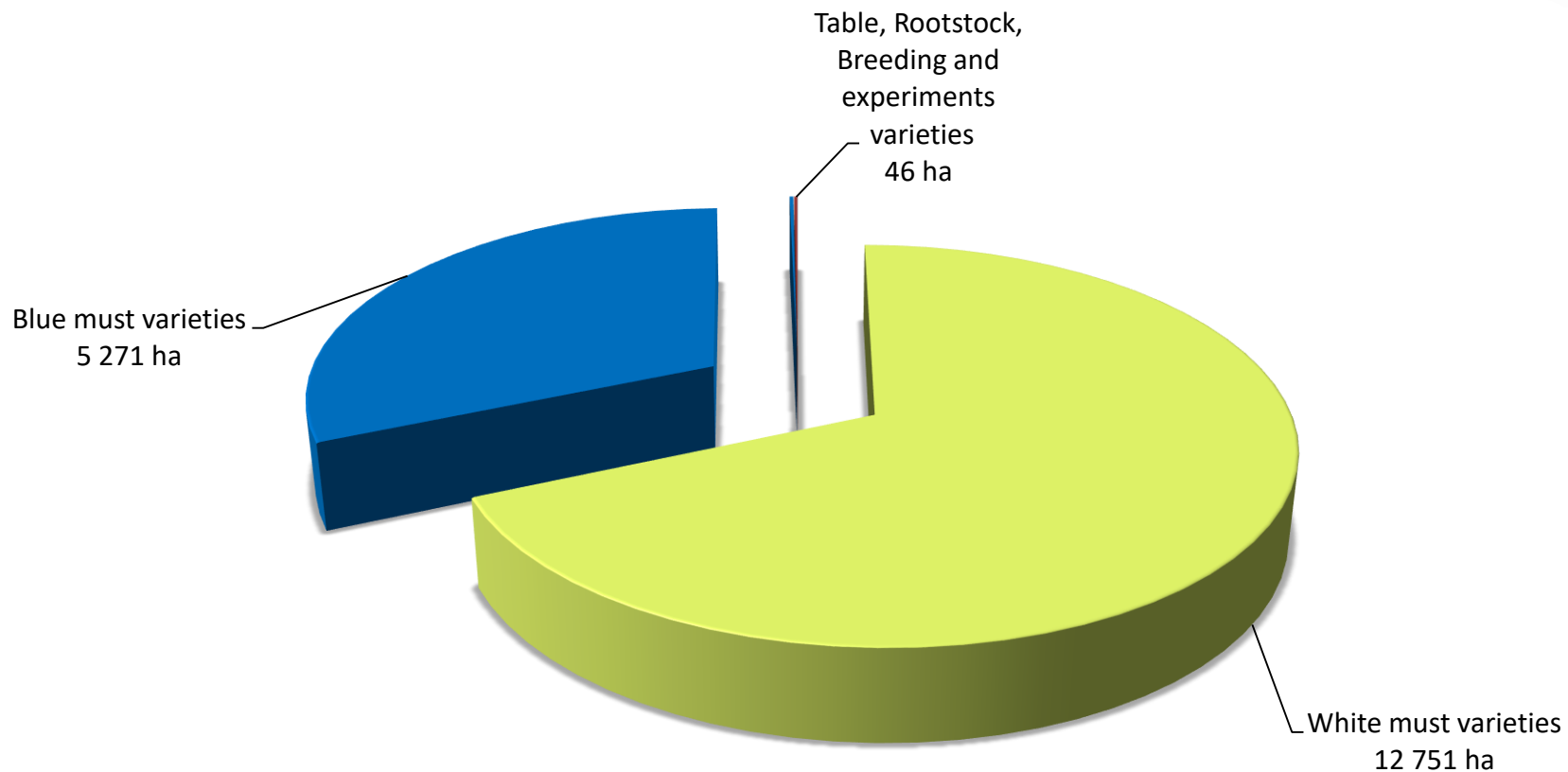

newly registered in CZ in recent years

- **White must varieties** – Mery, Svojsen, Rulenska, Medea, Tristar
- **Blue must varieties** – Cabernet Cortis, Acolon, Blauburger



Classification of Wines in 2018

- **Czech Agriculture and Food Inspection Authority** verified the sugar content of **51 592 307 kg of grapes**
- A total of **6,689 lots of wines** were classified, representing **304,552 hl of wine**.
- In terms of **volume**, the varietal quality wine was the most classified wine product (760 lots representing 123,780 hl of wine).
- In terms of the **number of samples**, the category of quality wine with attribute of late harvest significantly exceeded (3,985 lots representing 122,764 hl).
- 4,100 hl of wine was certified as VOC = **wine of the original certification**.



Integrated and Ecological Production

- **Integrated Production**

Average Yield 5 t/ha

- **Biodynamic Production**

Area of Vineyards . . . 597 ha,

Average Yield 4.5 - 5 t/ha

Wine awards

In 2018, winemakers from the Czech Republic were awarded 909 medals from various international world wine competitions.

- *Vinalies Internationales (Paris)* - 16 gold medals
- *Concours Mondial de Bruxelles (Beijing)* - 13 gold medals
- *Decanter World Wine Awards (London)* – 1 platinum medal
- *Great American International Wine Competition (New York)* - 5 grand gold medals
- *San Francisco International Wine Competition* - 3 grand gold medals
- *AWC Vienna* - 347 medals
- *MUVINA Prešov* – 4 titles of Champion
- *Vino Ljubljana* – 1 title of Champion
