## TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN

The Embassy of the Czech Republic in London confirms that all passport applications must be submitted in person during a previously arranged appointment.

The legislation governing travel documents stipulates a deadline of 120 days for the passport to be delivered to the Embassy or Consulate General starting from the day, when the application for the passport was submitted.

If the applicant does not hold any valid proof of identity and Czech citizenship, multiple in person appointments at the Embassy or Consulate General may be necessary. In this case, the process of obtaining a valid Czech passport may take considerably longer.

In case the applicant is a child born in abroad which has not been registered with the Czech authorities and has not been assigned a personnel number multiple in person appointments at the Embassy or Consulate General are necessary to register the child and apply for their first passport. From procedural point of view, it is not possible to obtain a Czech biometric passport within 3 months of child's birth when applying from abroad.
