PROCEDURE ON IMPLEMENTATION TO RESTRICT OF MOVEMENT BY THE IMMIGRATION DEPARTMENT

I hereby refer to the above matter.

- 2. YAB Prime Minister of Malaysia has decided to restrict the movement in the country effective 18th March 2020 till 31st March 2020.
- 3. This restriction will involve all Malaysian Citizens and Permanent Residents traveling abroad and all visitor and foreign nationals into the country. Please take note and inform all airlines operating in Malaysia as follows:
 - 3.1 Malaysian citizens and Permanent Residents coming back from abroad, has to go through health screening and self-quarantine for 14 days.

- Malaysian citizens and Permanent Residents holding work permit from the third countries who wish to return will be allowed to do so with a condition not to enter before 31st March 2020. Subjects are required to produce relevant documents at the point of departure.
- 3.3 Malaysian Diplomats serving abroad are allowed to leave the country.
- 3.4 All visitors and foreign nationals are allowed to leave the country and shall not enter until further notice.
- 3.5 All Expatriate Pass, Student Pass, Dependent Pass, Temporary Work Pass and MM2H Pass holders will not be allowed to enter the country. If the pass expires while in their respective countries, the holder will be allowed to enter after the restriction order has been lifted.
- 3.6 Malaysian citizen and Permanent Residents will be denied to travel aboard on holidays.
- 3.7 Spouse and children of citizen holding long term pass are allowed to enter the country.
- 3.8 Foreign Diplomats serving in Malaysia are allowed to enter the country but have to self-quarantine for 14 days. Families of Foreign Diplomats are allowed to enter providing they are issued with a Dependent Pass.

- 3.9 Airlines and Cargo crews including private jets are required to go through health screening before immigration clearance.
- 3.10 Transit and connecting flights passengers who does not required immigration clearance are allowed to board.
- 4. This order is effective from 18th March 2020 till 31st March 2020. Any changes will be notify from time to time. For further enquiries, please refer to the Security and Passport Division, Immigration Department of Malaysia, Putrajaya. Your kind cooperation on this matter is highly appreciated.
