



Almost a legendary film directed by Vojtěch Jasný, shows a story taking place in a picturesque Moravian village in May, 1945. People are simply enjoying those beautiful days of their lives. They all meet in a pub, drink wine and enjoy the music. However, these carefree days are coming to an end in February, 1948, when the village gets divided into two rivalled parts. The relaxing days are over...

Director Vojtěch Jasný had been collecting information for almost 20 years in order to provide us with this narrative. The film is considered to have one of the deepest stories in the history of Czechoslovakian cinematography. During communism the existence of this movie was carefully hidden, but transmitted among the people on more than 100 videotapes. The story is not only descriptive, but also poetic along the drama of the main characters that are in conflict with violence and cruelty.

Vojtěch Jasný, who was awarded at the Cannes Film Festival 1968, discovered along the way, many actors that became crucial for the history of Czech cinematography, such as the talented Radoslav Brzobohatý (official text of the distributor)
